CASE 01

The signed jerseys were taken from the coach's office of Aldermarsh Arena during the overnight window between 19:15 and 21:15. Investigators have narrowed the field to 6 suspects: Vidal (star player), Quincy (equipment manager), Thora (referee), Ronan (athletic trainer), Mira (team captain), Aiko (head coach).

Q Who took the signed jerseys?

1. Mira's locker-room sensor places them at a public event with hundreds of attendees from 19:15 to roughly 21:15.
2. Locker code access to the coach's office is restricted to Vidal, Quincy.
3. Thora's badge log places them at an offsite location from 19:15 to roughly 21:15.
4. Quincy's witness teammate places them at an offsite location from 19:15 to roughly 21:15.
5. The theft required medical sedative protocols. Only Vidal, Mira, Aiko have it among the suspects.
6. Vidal had a documented grievance, well-documented in HR records.
7. Vidal's locker code was activated at 19:15 at the coach's office.
8. Ronan's equipment sign-out places them at a public event with hundreds of attendees from 19:15 to roughly 21:15.
9. Vidal has no verifiable account of their whereabouts after 19:15.
- 10 A discarded note near the scene briefly suggested Aiko's involvement, but it was later traced . to an unrelated incident.

CASE 02

The production funds were taken from the green room of Helix Repertory during the overnight window between 21:45 and 23:30. Investigators have narrowed the field to 5 suspects: Saoirse (stage manager), Zinnia (stagehand), Hadley (lighting tech), Jules (box-office manager), Jacinta (understudy).

Q Who took the production funds?

1. The theft required social-engineering skill. Only Zinnia, Hadley, Jules have it among the suspects.
2. Saoirse's dressing-room sign-in places them at an offsite location from 21:45 to roughly 23:30.
3. Zinnia's prop-room code was activated at 21:45 at the green room.
4. Zinnia had passed-over promotion, well-documented in HR records.
5. Hadley's box-office system places them at a documented training session from 21:45 to roughly 23:30.
6. Zinnia has no verifiable account of their whereabouts after 21:45.
7. Prop-room code access to the green room is restricted to Zinnia, Jules, Jacinta.
8. Jules's props inventory log places them at a documented training session from 21:45 to roughly 23:30.
9. A discarded note near the scene briefly suggested Jules's involvement, but it was later traced to an unrelated incident.

CASE 03

1. Dario's parts-room audit places them at a public event with hundreds of attendees from 19:30 to roughly 21:30.
2. A discarded note near the scene briefly suggested Akira's involvement, but it was later traced to an unrelated incident.
3. Akira's door sensor places them at a documented training session from 19:30 to roughly 21:30.
4. The theft required complex schematic knowledge. Only Ramona, Dario, Mauro have it among the suspects.
5. Ramona has no verifiable account of their whereabouts after 19:30.
6. Mira's tool-checkout log places them at a documented training session from 19:30 to roughly 21:30.
7. Mauro's time-clock log places them at a public event with hundreds of attendees from 19:30 to roughly 21:30.
8. Ramona's parts-room code was activated at 19:30 at the welding bay.

4. Ravi's door sensor places them at a remote conference from 19:30 to roughly 21:30.
5. Sami has no verifiable account of their whereabouts after 19:30.
6. Alessio's shop camera places them at a documented training session from 19:30 to roughly 21:30.
7. Sami's parts-room code was activated at 19:30 at the main shop floor.
8. A discarded note near the scene briefly suggested Alessio's involvement, but it was later traced to an unrelated incident.
9. Sami had an ongoing dispute with management, well-documented in HR records.

- ☒ The theft required social-engineering skill, prop-room code, and a motivating reason.
 - ☒ Saoirse lacks the required social-engineering skill – cleared.

Case 03 D) Joaquin

- ☒ The theft required medical sedative protocols, master key, and a motivating reason.
 - ☒ Tariq has the skill but no master key – cleared.

Case 04 D) Ramona

- ☒ The theft required complex schematic knowledge, parts-room code, and a motivating reason.
 - ☒ Dario has the skill but no parts-room code – cleared.

- ☒ The theft required advanced lock-picking expertise, tool-crib key, and a motivating reason.
 - ☒ Eleni has the skill but no tool-crib key – cleared.

 - ☒ Yvonne lacks the required social-engineering skill – cleared.
